











There are 5 fundamental British values:

Democracy

The British parliament is based on democracy, democracy allows ordinary people to have a say in what the government does. This allows voters to decide how their country or community is run. By law you must be 18 years of age to vote.

Rule of Law

Rule of Law concerns the relationship between the state and its citizens, and states that no one is above the law. All UK citizens must obey the law and are equal under it.

Individual Liberty
